



GlassRenu® Background Information

GlassRenu® was started in August of 2006 to address the rising issue of damaged glass present in the marketplace. After researching and testing all available products on the market to remove surface damage from flat glass, the company's founders, hands-on glass repair experts, determined that none of the available glass repair systems performed well enough to make scratch removal a profitable endeavor.

Starting with a concept and a strong desire to solve this problem, GlassRenu released its first product in September of 2006, the Commercial Grade Scratch Removal System. Preliminary response to this wet-grinding system was less than stellar and GlassRenu's founders decided to deconstruct the process and rethink every aspect of glass repair. Rejecting 'old-school' thinking, the founders decided to pursue the unimaginable – developing a 'dry-grinding' process, which offered the potential for faster repairs, removal of deeper scratches and the elimination of the mess associated with wet-grinding systems.

By mid-2007, GlassRenu successfully introduced the Contractor Grade Scratch Removal System and accompanying RenuDisks – the first and only dry-grinding professional system available anywhere (patents pending). The response to this revolutionary system and its distortion-free results has been overwhelmingly positive. Currently available on two continents, GlassRenu estimates its systems have repaired more than 594,000 square feet of glass. In early 2009, GlassRenu introduced another industry first: a Performance Guarantee providing a distortion-free result.

As GlassRenu continues to grow, it remains committed to seeking ways to improve its products and make them easier to use, faster at damage removal and cleaner than all other systems on the market. Notably, GlassRenu users have yet to report back to the company about any flat glass damage that they have not been able to remove, including scratch tag graffiti, acid etch graffiti, welding slag damage, re-bar cutting damage, paint damage and sanding damage. In fact, some users have found that the Contractor Grade System is so effective, it can also assist in the removal of severe hard water stains.

GlassRenu products are distributed throughout North America and Europe and will soon be found in other international markets.
